## Electricity Tariffs on King Island and Flinders Island

The following tariff schedule is published under the provisions of the *Electricity Supply Industry Act (1995)* and *Regulation 5(1)* of the *Electricity Supply Industry (Tariff Customers) Regulations 2008*.

The following schedule should be read in conjunction with Hydro Tasmania's Standard Tariff Agreement and Customer Charter for King and Flinders Islands.

Tariffs have increased 3.60% as a result of inflation since the last increase in charges on 1 January 2011.

### Cancellation of Service

Electricity will be supplied to customers on the basis of the published tariffs as from 1 February 2012 and any customer not wishing to receive power on that basis should notify Hydro Tasmania's service provider, Aurora Energy, to arrange a disconnection.

### King and Flinders Islands Supply, All Customers – Tariff 5 I

Services charge.....	73.37¢ per day
Meter charge.....	7.19¢ per meter per day
Energy (all units).....	25.10¢ per kWh

### Pensioners

Services charge.....	73.37¢ per day
Meter charge.....	7.19¢ per meter per day
Energy (all units).....	25.10¢ per kWh
Energy rebate.....	111.70¢ per day

### Connection Fees

- For requirements of up to 25kVA, \$1,540.39 plus \$343.28 per kVA of capacity in excess of 4.5kVA. For requirements above 25kVA, actual cost of replacement or installation, including all material, labour, overheads, delivery and other relevant incidental costs, AND
- the actual costs incurred in extending or augmenting the distribution system having regard to the installation of new poles and wires, plus 15% to cover maintenance and service costs.

### Schedule of Supply Fees

- New application for supply for an installation which is or has previously been connected to Hydro Tasmania supply .....\$79.59
- New application for supply for an installation which is or has previously been connected to Hydro Tasmania supply where same day reconnection is required.....\$174.31
- Reconnection of all or part of an electrical installation after disconnection requested by the customer while in constant occupancy.....\$79.59
- Same day reconnection of all or part of an electrical installation after disconnection requested by a customer while in constant occupation.....\$174.31
- Special meter reading taken at customer's request .....\$79.59
- Attendance by an authorised officer of Hydro Tasmania or its service provider, at premises to disconnect supply for which payment is overdue:
  - Where payment of the overdue account is made .....\$79.59
  - or
  - Where payment of the overdue account is not made and the supply is disconnected and subsequently reconnected.....\$79.59
- Deposit for test of accuracy of a meter at the customer's request where the meter has been tested in the previous twelve months,
  - single or three phase meter .....\$101.10
  - or
  - current transformer meter.....\$388.57
- Late payment fee for accounts not paid in full by the fifth day past the due date (Pensioner, Health Care Card and other exemptions apply) .....\$5.00

### Reconnection fees

A customer who requires supply or a portion thereof to be disconnected and, after the date of the disconnection, requires the same electrical installation to be reconnected, must pay the scheduled fee and any services charge applicable under the relevant tariff for the period of disconnection.

### General

New tariffs will be applied on a pro-rata basis commencing with the first customer bills issued after 1 February 2012.

The above supply fees are the standard fees charged by Aurora Energy on mainland Tasmania and will be adjusted on 1 July each year.
