### Water release into spiral case

#### Summary

Mackintosh Power Station is currently undergoing a Major Maintenance Outage with multiple active work fronts.

During servicing of the intake still well, the drain valves were opened to remove water. This resulted in water entering the penstock, flowing into the spiral case, and exiting through the spiral case access hatch.

The spiral case was considered an active work area; however, no personnel were inside at the time of the water release. **Note** - The still well drain valves are not typically isolated to provide safe access into the spiral case.
